## A BILL

To amend chapter 71 of title 5, United States Code, to prohibit the use of Federal funds for certain Federal employee labor organization activities, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION OF FEDERAL FUNDS FOR CER-**  
4 **TAIN FEDERAL EMPLOYEE LABOR ORGANIZA-**  
5 **TION ACTIVITIES.**

6 (a) PAY OF FEDERAL EMPLOYEES.—Section 7131 of  
7 title 5, United States Code, is amended by adding at the  
8 end the following new subsection:

1       “(e) An agency may not pay an employee for any pe-  
2 riod of official time authorized under this section.”.

3       (b) **FACILITIES AND SUPPORT SERVICES.**—Section  
4 7135 of title 5, United States Code, is amended by adding  
5 at the end the following new subsection:

6       “(e) An agency may not expend funds for facilities  
7 or support services for any labor organization pursuant  
8 to policies, regulations, or procedures referred to under  
9 subsection (b).”.
