## A BILL

For the relief of Fanie Phily Mateo Angeles, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR FANIE**  
4 **PHILY MATEO ANGELES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any provision of  
6 the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101 et  
7 seq.), Fanie Phily Mateo Angeles shall be held and consid-  
8 ered to have been lawfully admitted to the United States  
9 for permanent residence as of the date of the enactment  
10 of this Act.

1 (b) VISA FEE.—Subsection (a) shall become effective  
2 on the payment of the required visa fee for permanent res-  
3 idence.

4 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION IN NUMBER OF IMMIGRANT VISAS.**

5 On the granting of permanent residence status to  
6 Fanie Phily Mateo Angeles under section 1, the Secretary  
7 of State shall reduce by the proper number, during fiscal  
8 year 1995 or 1996, the number of immigrant visas that  
9 are made available to natives of the country of birth of  
10 Fanie Phily Mateo Angeles, under sections 203(a) and  
11 202(e) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.  
12 1153(a) and 1152(e)).
