A BILL

To provide for the retention of the name of the mountain at the Devils Tower National Monument in Wyoming known as “Devils Tower”, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF DEVILS TOWER.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The mountain at the Devils
5 Tower National Monument in Wyoming, located at 44 de-
6 grees, 42 minutes, 58 seconds north latitude, 104 degrees,
7 35 minutes, 32 seconds west longitude, shall be known and
8 designated as “Devils Tower”.

1 (b) LEGAL REFERENCES.—Any reference in any law,
2 map, regulation, document, paper, or other record of the
3 United States to the mountain referred to in subsection
4 (a) is deemed to be a reference to “Devils Tower”.
