A BILL

To provide for the Advisory Commission on Intergovernmental Relations to continue in existence, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. (a) Notwithstanding the provision under
4 the heading “ADVISORY COMMISSION ON INTERGOVERN-
5 MENTAL RELATIONS” under title IV of the Treasury, Post-
6 al Service, and General Government Appropriations Act,
7 1996 (Public Law 104–52; 109 Stat. 480), the Advisory
8 Commission on Intergovernmental Relations may continue
9 in existence solely for the purpose of performing any con-
10 tract entered into under section 7(a) of the National Gam-

1 bling Impact Study Commission Act (Public Law 104–
2 169; 110 Stat. 1487). The Advisory Commission on Inter-
3 governmental Relations shall terminate on the date of the
4 completion of such contract.

5 (b) The Advisory Commission on Intergovernmental
6 Relations and employees of the Commission who are con-
7 sidered to be Federal employees under section 6(e) of Pub-
8 lic Law 96–380 (42 U.S.C. 4276(e)) shall make contribu-
9 tions to and participate in Federal health insurance, life
10 insurance, and retirement programs to the same extent
11 and in the same manner as before the date of enactment
12 of this section. The Commission shall make any such con-
13 tributions from funds received through contracts.

14 SEC. 2. Section 615 of the Departments of Com-
15 merce, Justice, and State, the Judiciary, and Related
16 Agencies Appropriations Act, 1997 (contained in Pub. L.
17 No. 104–208) is amended by deleting “and Community
18 Oriented Policing Services Program” and by deleting “and
19 part Q of title I of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe
20 Streets Act of 1968”. The amendments made by this sec-
21 tion shall take effect upon enactment.

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
