## A BILL

To provide for the termination of reporting requirements of certain executive reports submitted to the Congress, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF REPORTING REQUIREMENTS.**

4       (a) SHORT TITLE.—This Act may be cited as the  
5       “Reporting Requirements Sunset Act of 1995”.

6       (b) TERMINATION.—

7               (1) IN GENERAL.—Subject to the provisions of  
8       paragraph (2), each provision of law requiring the  
9       submittal to Congress (or any committee of the Con-  
10      gress) of any report specified on the list described

1 under subsection (d) shall cease to be effective, with  
2 respect to that requirement, 5 years after the date  
3 of the enactment of this Act.

4 (2) EXCEPTION.—The provisions of paragraph  
5 (1) shall not apply to any report required under—

6 (A) the Inspector General Act of 1978 (5  
7 U.S.C. App.; Public Law 95–452); or

8 (B) the Chief Financial Officers Act of  
9 1990 (Public Law 101–576).

10 (c) IDENTIFICATION OF WASTEFUL REPORTS.—The  
11 President shall include in the first annual budget submit-  
12 ted pursuant to section 1105 of title 31, United States  
13 Code, after the date of enactment of this Act a list of re-  
14 ports that the President has determined are unnecessary  
15 or wasteful and the reasons for such determination.

16 (d) LIST OF REPORTS.—The list referred to under  
17 subsection (b) is the list prepared by the Clerk of the  
18 House of Representatives for the first session of the 103d  
19 Congress under clause 2 of rule III of the Rules of the  
20 House of Representatives.
