A BILL

To increase the penalties for sexual exploitation of children, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Prevention of Sexual
5 Exploitation of Children Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PENALTIES.**

7 (a) SEXUAL EXPLOITATION OF CHILDREN.—Section
8 2251(d) of title 18, United States Code, is amended—

9 (1) by striking “10 years” and inserting “15
10 years”; and

1 (2) by striking “more than 15 years” and in-
2 serting “more than 20 years”.

3 (b) CERTAIN ACTIVITIES RELATING TO MATERIAL
4 INVOLVING THE SEXUAL EXPLOITATION OF MINORS.—
5 Section 2252(b)(1) of title 18, United States Code, is
6 amended—

7 (1) by striking “ten years” and inserting “15
8 years”; and

9 (2) by striking “more than fifteen years” and
10 inserting “more than 20 years”.
