**A BILL**

To stop the waste of taxpayer funds on activities by Government agencies to encourage its employees or officials to accept homosexuality as a legitimate or normal lifestyle.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON USE OF APPROPRIATED**  
4 **FUNDS.**

5 No funds appropriated out of the Treasury of the  
6 United States may be used by any entity to fund, promote,

1 or carry out any seminar or program for employees of the  
2 Government, or to fund any position in the Government,  
3 the purpose of which is to compel, instruct, encourage,  
4 urge, or persuade employees or officials to—

5           (1) recruit, on the basis of sexual orientation,  
6           homosexuals for employment with the Government;

7           or

8           (2) embrace, accept, condone, or celebrate ho-  
9           mosexuality as a legitimate or normal lifestyle.
