A BILL

To prohibit the Secretary of Agriculture from transferring any national forest system lands in the Angeles National Forest in California out of Federal ownership for use as a solid waste landfill.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION OF CERTAIN TRANSFERS OF NA-**
4 **TIONAL FOREST LANDS.**

5 (a) PROHIBITION.—The Secretary of Agriculture
6 shall not transfer (by exchange or otherwise) any land
7 owned by the United States and managed by the Secretary
8 as part of the Angeles National Forest to any person un-

1 less the instrument of conveyance contains a restriction,
2 enforceable by the Secretary, on the future use of the land
3 prohibiting the use of any portion of the land as a solid
4 waste landfill.

5 (b) ENFORCEMENT.—The Secretary shall act to en-
6 force a restriction described in subsection (a) as soon as
7 possible when and if a violation of the restriction occurs.
