**A BILL**

To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to update references in the classification of children for purposes of United States immigration laws.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DEFINITION OF CHILD.**

4 Section 101(b) of the Immigration and Nationality  
5 Act (8 U.S.C. 1101(b)) is amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (1)—

2 (A) in subparagraph (A), by striking “le-  
3 gitimate child” and inserting “child born in  
4 wedlock”; and

5 (B) in subparagraph (D), by striking “an  
6 illegitimate child” and inserting “a child born  
7 out of wedlock”; and

8 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking “an illegit-  
9 imate child” and inserting “a child born out of wed-  
10 lock”.
