## A BILL

To extend the authorization for certain programs under the Native American Programs Act of 1974, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR NA-**  
4 **TIVE AMERICAN SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC DE-**  
5 **VELOPMENT STRATEGIES GRANT PROGRAM.**

6 Section 816 of the Native American Programs Act  
7 of 1974 (42 U.S.C. 2992d) is amended—

8 (1) in subsection (a), by striking “for fiscal  
9 years 1992, 1993, 1994, and 1995.” and inserting

1 “for each of fiscal years 1995, 1996, 1997, 1998,  
2 and 1999.”; and

3 (2) in subsection (c), by striking “and 1996,”  
4 and inserting “1996, 1997, 1998, and 1999,”.
