**A BILL**

To extend the deadline under the Federal Power Act applicable to the construction of three hydroelectric projects in the State of Arkansas.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3        **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DEADLINES.**

4        Notwithstanding the time limitations of section 13 of  
5        the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806), the Federal En-  
6        ergy Regulatory Commission, upon the request of the li-

1 censee for FERC projects numbered 4204, 4660, and  
2 4659 (and after reasonable notice), is authorized, in ac-  
3 cordance with the good faith, due diligence, and public in-  
4 terest requirements of section 13 and the Commission's  
5 procedures under such section, to extend the time required  
6 for commencement of construction of the projects for a  
7 maximum of three consecutive two-year periods. This sec-  
8 tion shall take effect for the project upon the expiration  
9 of the extension (issued by the Commission under section  
10 13) of the period required for commencement of such  
11 project.
