1 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF BRUCE R. THOMPSON**
2 **UNITED STATES COURTHOUSE AND FEDERAL**
3 **BUILDING.**

4 The United States courthouse and Federal building
5 to be constructed at the southeastern corner of Liberty
6 and South Virginia Streets in Reno, Nevada, shall be
7 known and designated as the “Bruce R. Thompson United
8 States Courthouse and Federal Building”.

9 **SEC. 2. LEGAL REFERENCES.**

10 Any reference in a law, regulation, document, record,
11 map, or other paper of the United States to the courthouse
12 and Federal building referred to in section 1 shall be
13 deemed to be a reference to the “Bruce R. Thompson
14 United States Courthouse and Federal Building”.
