## A BILL

To amend the Clean Air Act to extend the deadline for the imposition of sanctions under section 179 of the Act that relate to a State vehicle inspection and maintenance program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF SANCTIONS DEADLINE.**

4 (a) EXTENSION.—Section 179(a) of the Clean Air  
5 Act (42 U.S.C. 7509(a)) is amended in the matter follow-  
6 ing paragraph (4) by inserting “(or, in the case of a re-  
7 quirement relating to a State vehicle inspection and main-  
8 tenance program, 30 months)” after “18 months”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) shall take effect with respect to any finding,  
3 disapproval, or determination made under section 179(a)  
4 of the Clean Air Act after the date that is 18 months prior  
5 to the date of enactment of this Act.
