A BILL

To designate the Federal building at 1314 LeMay Boulevard, Ellsworth Air Force Base, South Dakota, as the “Cartney Koch McRaven Child Development Center”, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF CARTNEY KOCH MCRAVEN**
4 **CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Federal building at 1314
6 LeMay Boulevard, Ellsworth Air Force Base, South Da-
7 kota, shall be known and designated as the “Cartney Koch
8 McRaven Child Development Center”.

1 (b) REPLACEMENT BUILDING.—If, after the date of
2 enactment of this Act, a new Federal building is built at
3 the location described in subsection (a) to replace the
4 building described in the subsection, the new Federal
5 building shall be known and designated as the “Cartney
6 Koch McRaven Child Development Center”.

7 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

8 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
9 paper, or other record of the United States to a Federal
10 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be
11 a reference to the “Cartney Koch McRaven Child Develop-
12 ment Center”.
