## A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to add multiple deaths as an aggravating factor in determining whether a sentence of death is to be imposed on a defendant, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MULTIPLE DEATHS AS AGGRAVATING FACTOR.**

4 Section 3592(c) of title 18, United States Code, is  
5 amended by adding at the end the following new para-  
6 graph:

1           “(16) MULTIPLE DEATHS.—The death, or in-  
2           jury resulting in death, of more than 1 person, oc-  
3           curred during the commission of the crime.”.
