## A BILL

To provide for the liquidation or reliquidation of a certain entry of warp knitting machines as free of certain duties.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RELIQUIDATING ENTRY OF WARP KNITTING**  
4 **MACHINES.**

5 Notwithstanding section 514 of the Tariff Act of  
6 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514) or any other provision of law, upon  
7 proper request filed with the Customs Service before the  
8 180th day after the date of the enactment of this Act,  
9 the Secretary of the Treasury shall—

1           (1) liquidate or reliquidate as duty free Entry  
2           No. 100-3022436-3, made on July 12, 1989, at the  
3           port of Charleston, South Carolina; and

4           (2) refund any duties and interest paid with re-  
5           spect to such entry.
