A BILL

To amend the Illinois and Michigan Canal Heritage Corridor Act of 1984 to modify the boundaries of the corridor, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF CORRIDOR BOUNDARIES.**

4 Section 104(b)(1) of the Illinois and Michigan Canal
5 National Heritage Corridor Act of 1984 (Public Law 98-
6 398; 16 U.S.C. 461 note) is amended by striking para-
7 graph (1) and inserting the following:

1 “(1) IN GENERAL.—The corridor shall consist
2 of the Joliet Army Ammunition Plant in the State
3 of Illinois and the areas depicted on—

4 “(A) the map entitled ‘Illinois and Michi-
5 gan Canal National Heritage Corridor’, dated
6 May 1983 and numbered IMC-80,000;

7 “(B) the map entitled ‘Illinois and Michi-
8 gan Canal National Heritage Corridor—Bound-
9 ary Definition for portions of the Corridor East
10 of Harlem Avenue’, dated _____ and
11 numbered _____; and

12 “(C) the map entitled ‘Illinois and Michi-
13 gan Canal National Heritage Corridor—Bound-
14 ary Definition for the Lake Renwick Zone’,
15 dated _____ and numbered
16 _____,

17 each of which maps shall be on file and available for
18 public inspection in the offices of the Commission
19 and in the offices of the National Park Service.”.

20 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF DURATION OF COMMISSION.**

21 Section 111(a) of the Illinois and Michigan Canal Na-
22 tional Heritage Corridor Act of 1984 (Public Law 98-398;
23 16 U.S.C. 461 note) is amended by striking “ten” and
24 inserting “20”.
