Mr. DOLE submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional recess or adjournment of the Senate on Monday, November 20, 1995, until Monday, November 27, 1995, and a conditional adjournment of the House on the legislative day of Monday, November 20, 1995, or Tuesday, November 21, 1995, until Tuesday, November 28, 1995.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That when the Senate recesses or adjourns
3 at the close of business on Monday, November 20, 1995,
4 pursuant to a motion made by the majority leader or his
5 designee, in accordance with this resolution, it stand re-
6 cessed or adjourned until a time to be determined by the

1 majority leader on Monday, November 27, 1995, or until
2 one hour after the House has voted on H.J. Res. 122,
3 unless the House agrees to the Senate amendment.

4 SEC. 2. The two Houses shall convene at 12:00 noon
5 on the second day after Members are notified to reassem-
6 ble pursuant to section 3 of this resolution, whichever oc-
7 curs first; and that when the House of Representatives
8 adjourns on the legislative day of Monday, November 20,
9 1995, or the legislative day of Tuesday, November 21,
10 1995, it stand adjourned until 12:30 p.m. on Tuesday,
11 November 28, 1995, or until 12:00 noon on the second
12 day after Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to
13 section 3 of this resolution, whichever occurs first.

14 SEC. 3. The majority leader of the Senate and the
15 Speaker of the House, acting jointly after consultation
16 with the minority leader of the Senate and the minority
17 leader of the House, shall notify the Members of the Sen-
18 ate and the House, respectively, to reassemble whenever,
19 in their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
