1 eral Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and
2 Herzegovina and its associated annexes.

3 **SEC. 2. EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR UNITED STATES MILI-**
4 **TARY PERSONNEL WHO ARE DEPLOYED.**

5 The Congress strongly supports the United States
6 military personnel who may be ordered by the President
7 to implement the General Framework Agreement for
8 Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina and its associated an-
9 nexes.

10 **SEC. 3. TRANSMITTAL OF RESOLUTION.**
