CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the rotunda of the United States Capitol to be used on January 20, 1997, in connection with the proceedings and ceremonies for the inauguration of the President-elect and the Vice President-elect of the United States.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That (a) the rotunda of the United States
3 Capitol is hereby authorized to be used on January 20,
4 1997, by the Joint Congressional Committee on Inaugural
5 Ceremonies (the “Joint Committee”) in connection with
6 the proceedings and ceremonies conducted for the inau-

1 guration of the President-elect and the Vice President-
2 elect of the United States.

3 (b) The Joint Committee is authorized to utilize ap-
4 propriate equipment and the services of appropriate per-
5 sonnel of departments and agencies of the Federal Gov-
6 ernment, under arrangements between such Committee
7 and the heads of such departments and agencies, in con-
8 nection with such proceedings and ceremonies. The Joint
9 Committee may accept gifts and donations of goods and
10 services to carry out its responsibilities.
