CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To express the sense of Congress that the Secretary of Agriculture should dispose of all remaining commodities in the disaster reserve maintained under the Agricultural Act of 1970 to relieve the distress of livestock producers whose ability to maintain livestock is adversely affected by the prolonged drought conditions existing in certain areas of the United States, and for other purposes.

1 **SECTION 1. USE OF DISASTER RESERVE FOR ASSISTANCE**
2 **TO LIVESTOCK PRODUCERS.**

3 In light of the prolonged drought conditions existing
4 in certain areas of the United States, the Secretary of Ag-
5 riculture should promptly dispose of all commodities in the
6 disaster reserve maintained under section 813 of the Agri-
7 cultural Act of 1970 (7 U.S.C. 1427a) to relieve the dis-
8 tress of livestock producers whose ability to maintain live-
9 stock is adversely affected by the prolonged drought.
