Mr. DOLE (for himself and Mr. DASCHLE) submitted the following resolution;

RESOLUTION

To authorize representation by Senate Legal Counsel.

Whereas, in the case of Committee for Judicial Review v. The United States Senate Committee on the Judiciary, Senator Orrin Hatch, No. 1:95CV0770, pending in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia, the plaintiff has filed a complaint, seeking, among other relief, to restrain the Committee on the Judiciary from conducting confirmation hearings on the nomination of Peter C. Economus, who has been nominated to be a United States District Judge for the Northern District of Ohio; and

Whereas, pursuant to sections 703(a) and 704(a)(1) of the Ethics in Government Act of 1978, 2 U.S.C. §§ 288b(a) and 288c(a)(1) (1994), the Senate may direct its counsel to defend committees and Members of the Senate in civil

actions relating to their official responsibilities: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the Senate Legal Counsel is author-
2 ized to represent the Committee on the Judiciary, its
3 chairman, Senator Orrin G. Hatch, and the other mem-
4 bers of the Committee on the Judiciary in the case of
5 Committee for Judicial Review v. The United States Sen-
6 ate Committee on the Judiciary, Senator Orrin Hatch.
