RESOLUTION

To refer S. 740, entitled “A bill for the relief of Inslaw, Inc., and William A. Hamilton and Nancy Burke Hamilton” to the chief judge of the United States Court of Federal Claims for a report thereon.

1 *Resolved*, That the bill S. 740, entitled “A bill for the
2 relief of Inslaw, Inc., and William A. Hamilton and Nancy
3 Burke Hamilton” now pending in the Senate, together
4 with all the accompanying papers, is referred to the chief
5 judge of the United States Court of Federal Claims. The
6 chief judge shall proceed with the same in accordance with
7 the provisions of sections 1492 and 2509 of title 28,
8 United States Code, and report thereon to the Senate, at

1 the earliest practicable date, giving such findings of fact
2 and conclusions thereon as shall be sufficient to inform
3 the Congress of the nature and character of the demand
4 as a claim, legal or equitable, against the United States
5 or a gratuity and the amount, if any, legally or equitably
6 due to the claimants from the United States.
