To authorize representation by Senate Legal Counsel.

Whereas, in the case of William D. (Bill) Peterson II v. The Honorable Senator Orrin G. Hatch, No. 95-C-0352-S, pending in the United States District Court for the District of Utah, the plaintiff has named Senator Orrin G. Hatch as the defendant; and

Whereas, pursuant to sections 703(a) and 704(a)(1) of the Ethics in Government Act of 1978, 2 U.S.C. §§ 288b(a) and 288c(a)(1) (1994), the Senate may direct its counsel to defend Members of the Senate in civil actions relating to their official responsibilities: Now, therefore, be it
