original resolution; which was placed on the calendar

**RESOLUTION**

Concerning the Select Committee on Ethics Investigation  
of Senator Packwood of Oregon.

1       *Resolved*, That pursuant to article 1, section 5, clause  
2 2 of the United States Constitution, Senator Packwood  
3 is expelled from the Senate for his illegal actions and im-  
4 proper conduct in attempting to obstruct and impede the  
5 Committee's inquiry; engaging in a pattern of sexual mis-  
6 conduct in at least 18 instances between 1969 and 1990;  
7 and engaging in a plan to enhance his financial position  
8 by soliciting, encouraging and coordinating employment

- 1 opportunities for his wife from individuals with interests
- 2 in legislation or issues which he could influence.
