Mr. DASCHLE submitted the following resolution; which was considered and agreed to

RESOLUTION

To amend paragraph 4 of rule XXV of the Standing Rules of the Senate.

1 *Resolved*, That paragraph 4 of rule XXV is amended
2 by striking (h)(1) through (h)(15) and inserting in lieu
3 thereof the following:

4 “(h)(1) A Senator who on the last day of the One
5 Hundred Third Congress was serving as a member of the
6 Committee on Environment and Public Works and the
7 Committee on Finance may, during the One Hundred
8 Fourth Congress, also serve as a member of the Commit-
9 tee on Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry so long as his
10 service as a member of each such committee is continuous,
11 but in no event may he serve, by reason of this subdivision,

1 as a member of more than three committees listed in para-
2 graph 2.

3 “(2) A Senator who on the last day of the One Hun-
4 dred Third Congress was serving as a member of the Com-
5 mittee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs and the
6 Committee on Foreign Relations may, during the One
7 Hundred Fourth Congress, also serve as a member of the
8 Committee on Labor and Human Resources so long as his
9 service as a member of each such committee is continuous,
10 but in no event may he serve, by reason of this subdivision,
11 as a member of more than three committees listed in para-
12 graph 2.

13 “(3) A Senator who on the last day of the One Hun-
14 dred Third Congress was serving as a member of the Com-
15 mittee on Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry and the
16 Committee on Appropriations may, during the One Hun-
17 dred Fourth Congress, also serve as a member of the Com-
18 mittee on Labor and Human Resources so long as his
19 service as a member of each such committee is continuous,
20 but in no event may he serve, by reason of this subdivision,
21 as a member of more than three committees listed in para-
22 graph 2.

23 “(4) A Senator who on the last day of the One Hun-
24 dred Third Congress was serving as a member of the Com-
25 mittee on the Judiciary and the Committee on Labor may,

1 during the One Hundred Fourth Congress, also serve as
2 a member of the Committee on Armed Services so long
3 as his service as a member of each such committee is con-
4 tinuous, but in no event may he serve, by reason of this
5 subdivision, as a member of more than three committees
6 listed in paragraph 2.

7 “(5) A Senator who on the last day of the One Hun-
8 dred Third Congress was serving as a member of the Com-
9 mittee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation and the
10 Committee on Foreign Relations may, during the One
11 Hundred Fourth Congress, also serve as a member of the
12 Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs so
13 long as his service as a member of each such committee
14 is continuous, but in no event may he serve, by reason
15 of this subdivision, as a member of more than three com-
16 mittees listed in paragraph 2.

17 “(6) A Senator who on the last day of the One Hun-
18 dred Third Congress was serving as a member of the Com-
19 mittee on Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry and the
20 Committee on Appropriations may, during the One Hun-
21 dred Fourth Congress, also serve as a member of the Com-
22 mittee on the Judiciary so long as his service as a member
23 of each such committee is continuous, but in no event may
24 he serve, by reason of this subdivision, as a member of
25 more than three committees listed in paragraph 2.

1 “(7) A Senator who on the last day of the One Hun-
2 dred Third Congress was serving as a member of the Com-
3 mittee on Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry and the
4 Committee on Finance may, during the One Hundred
5 Fourth Congress, also serve as a member of the Commit-
6 tee on Governmental Affairs so long as his service as a
7 member of each such committee is continuous, but in no
8 event may he serve, by reason of this subdivision, as a
9 member of more than three committees listed in para-
10 graph 2.

11 “(8) A Senator who on the last day of the One Hun-
12 dred Third Congress was serving as a member of the Com-
13 mittee on Armed Services and the Committee on Environ-
14 ment and Public Works may, during the One Hundred
15 Fourth Congress, also serve as a member of the Commit-
16 tee on Governmental Affairs so long as his service as a
17 member of each such committee is continuous, but in no
18 event may he serve, by reason of this subdivision, as a
19 member of more than three committees listed in para-
20 graph 2.

21 “(9) A Senator who on the last day of the One Hun-
22 dred Third Congress was serving as a member of the Com-
23 mittee on Armed Services and the Committee on Com-
24 merce, Science, and Transportation may, during the One
25 Hundred Fourth Congress, also serve as a member of the

1 Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs so
2 long as his service as a member of each such committee
3 is continuous, but in no event may he serve, by reason
4 of this subdivision, as a member of more than three com-
5 mittees listed in paragraph 2.
