RESOLUTION

To make certain technical changes to S. Res. 158.

1 *Resolved*, That (a) paragraph 1(c) of rule XXXV of
2 the Standing Rules of the Senate (as added by section 1
3 of S. Res. 158, agreed to July 28, 1995) is amended—

4 (1) in clause (3) by striking “section 107(2) of
5 title I the Ethics in Government Act of 1978 (Public
6 Law 95–521)” and inserting “section 109(16) of
7 title I of the Ethics Reform Act of 1989 (5 U.S.C
8 App. 6)”; and

9 (2) in clause (4)(A) by inserting “, including
10 personal hospitality,” after “Anything”.

1 (b) Paragraph 3 of rule XXXIV of the Standing
2 Rules of the Senate (as added by section 2(a) of S. Res.
3 158, agreed to July 28, 1995) is amended—

4 (1) in the matter before clause (a) by striking
5 “paragraph 2” and inserting “paragraph 1”; and

6 (2) in clause (b) by striking “income” and in-
7 serting “value”.

8 (c) Paragraph 4 of rule XXXIV of the Standing
9 Rules of the Senate (as added by section 2(b)(1) of S.
10 Res. 158, agreed to July 28, 1995) is amended by striking
11 “paragraph 2” and inserting “paragraph 1”.
