RESOLUTION

To express the sense of the Senate that the Secretary of Agriculture should allow livestock producers who had qualified for emergency livestock feed assistance in the 1995 crop year to be eligible for emergency livestock feed assistance in the 1996 crop year, and for other purposes.

2 **SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY FOR EMERGENCY LIVESTOCK**
3 **FEED ASSISTANCE.**

4 It is the sense of the Senate that, as part of the or-
5 derly termination of the emergency livestock feed assist-
6 ance program established under title VI of the Agricul-

1 tural Act of 1949 (7 U.S.C. 1471 et seq.), livestock pro-
2 ducers who were eligible for emergency livestock feed as-
3 sistance for the 1995 crop year, but were unable to apply
4 for the assistance for the 1996 crop year, and who have
5 suffered a qualifying loss as determined by the Secretary,
6 should be eligible to receive assistance under the program
7 through at least August 31, 1996.
