To authorize representation by Senate Legal Counsel.

Whereas, in the case of James Lockhart v. United States, et al., No. C95–1858Z, pending in the United States District Court for the Western District of Washington, the plaintiff has named Senator Trent Lott and former Senator Robert J. Dole as defendants; and

Whereas, pursuant to sections 703(a) and 704(a)(1) of the Ethics in Government Act of 1978 (2 U.S.C. §§ 288b(a) and 288c(a)(1)(1994)), the Senate may direct its counsel to defend its Members in civil actions relating to their official responsibilities: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the Senate Legal Counsel is author-
2 ized to represent Senator Lott and former Senator Dole
3 in the case of James Lockhart v. United States, et al.
