Mr. STEVENS submitted the following resolution; which was considered and agreed to

RESOLUTION

To provide for severance pay.

1 *Resolved*, (a) That the individual who was the Ser-
2 geant at Arms and Doorkeeper of the Senate on Septem-
3 ber 1, 1996, and whose service as the Sergeant at Arms
4 and Doorkeeper of the Senate terminated on or after Sep-
5 tember 1, 1996 but prior to September 6, 1996, shall be
6 entitled to one lump sum payment consisting of severance
7 pay in an amount equal to two months of the individual's
8 basic pay at the rate such individual was paid on Septem-
9 ber 1, 1996.

10 (b) The Secretary of the Senate shall make payments
11 under this resolution from funds appropriated for fiscal

1 year 1996 from the appropriation account “Miscellaneous
2 Items” within the contingent fund of the Senate.

3 (c) A payment under this resolution shall not be
4 treated as compensation for purposes of any provision of
5 title 5, United States Code, or of any other law relating
6 to benefits accruing from employment by the United
7 States, and the period of entitlement to such pay shall
8 not be treated as a period of employment for purposes of
9 any such provision of law.
