CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for an adjournment or recess of the two Houses.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Thursday, June 26, 1997, it stand adjourned
4 until 12:30 p.m. on Tuesday, July 8, 1997, or until noon
5 on the second day after Members are notified to reassem-

1 ble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution,
2 whichever occurs first; and that when the Senate recesses
3 or adjourns at the close of business on Thursday, June
4 26, 1997, Friday, June 27, 1997, Saturday, June 28,
5 1997, or Sunday, June 29, 1997, pursuant to a motion
6 made by the Majority Leader, or his designee, in accord-
7 ance with this concurrent resolution, it stand recessed or
8 adjourned until noon on Monday, July 7, 1997, or such
9 time on that day as may be specified by the Majority
10 Leader or his designee in the motion to recess or adjourn,
11 or until noon on the second day after Members are notified
12 to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent res-
13 olution, whichever occurs first.

14 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
15 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
16 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-
17 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House
18 and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in
19 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
