CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for an adjournment of the two Houses.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That, in consonance with section 132(a) of
3 the Legislative Reorganization Act of 1946, when the
4 House adjourns on the legislative day of Friday, August
5 1, 1997 or Saturday, August 2, 1997, pursuant to a mo-
6 tion made by the Majority Leader or his designee, it stand
7 adjourned until noon on Wednesday, September 3, 1997,
8 or until noon on the second day after Members are notified
9 to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent res-
10 olution, whichever occurs first; and that when the Senate
11 recesses or adjourns at the close of business on Thursday,
12 July 31, 1997, Friday, August 1, 1997, or Saturday, Au-
13 gust 2, 1997, pursuant to a motion made by the Majority

1 Leader or his designee in accordance with this concurrent
2 resolution, it stand recessed or adjourned until noon on
3 Tuesday, September 2, 1997, or until such time on that
4 day as may be specified by the Majority Leader or his
5 designee in the motion to recess or adjourn, or until noon
6 on the second day after Members are notified to reassem-
7 ble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution,
8 whichever occurs first.

9 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
10 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
11 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-
12 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House
13 and Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in their
14 opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
