Mr. ARMEY submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was considered and agreed to

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for an adjournment of the two Houses.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Wednesday, January 28, 1998, it stand ad-
4 journed until 12:30 p.m. on Tuesday, February 3, 1998;
5 that when the House adjourns on Thursday, February 5,
6 1998, it stand adjourned until 3:00 p.m. on Wednesday,
7 February 11, 1998; and that when the House adjourns
8 on Thursday, February 12, 1998, it stand adjourned until
9 12:30 p.m. on Tuesday, February 24, 1998, or until noon
10 on the second day after Members are notified to reassem-
11 ble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution,
12 whichever occurs first; and that when the Senate recesses

1 or adjourns at the close of business on Friday, February
2 13, 1998, pursuant to motion made by the Majority Lead-
3 er, or his designee, in accordance with this concurrent res-
4 olution, it stand recessed or adjourned until noon on Mon-
5 day, February 23, 1998, or such time on that day as may
6 be specified by the Majority Leader or his designee in the
7 motion to recess or adjourn, or until noon on the second
8 day after Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to
9 section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs
10 first.

11 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
12 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with
13 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-
14 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House
15 and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in
16 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
