Mr. SOLOMON (for himself, Mr. PETRI, Mr. TANNER, Mr. DINGELL, and Mr. ORTIZ) submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the use of the Capitol Grounds for a breast cancer survivors event sponsored by the National Race for the Cure.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF BREAST CANCER SUR-**
4 **VIVORS EVENT ON CAPITOL GROUNDS.**

5 The National Race for the Cure (referred to in this
6 resolution as the “Race”) may sponsor an event on the
7 Capitol Grounds on April 1, 1998, or on such other date
8 as the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the

1 President pro tempore of the Senate may jointly des-
2 ignate.

3 **SEC. 2. CONDITIONS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The event to be carried out under
5 this resolution shall be—

6 (1) free of admission charge; and

7 (2) arranged not to interfere with the needs of
8 Congress and under conditions to be prescribed by
9 the Architect of the Capitol and the Capitol Police
10 Board.

11 (b) RESPONSIBILITY.—The Race shall assume full re-
12 sponsibility for all expenses and liabilities incident to all
13 activities associated with the event.

14 **SEC. 3. STRUCTURES AND EQUIPMENT.**

15 For the purposes of this resolution, the Race may
16 erect upon the Capitol Grounds, subject to the approval
17 of the Architect of the Capitol, such stage, sound amplifi-
18 cation devices, commemorative pink ribbon, and other re-
19 lated structures and equipment as may be required for the
20 event to be carried out under this resolution.

21 **SEC. 4. ADDITIONAL ARRANGEMENTS.**

22 The Architect of the Capitol and the Capitol Police
23 Board may make any such additional arrangements that

1 may be required to carry out the event under this resolu-
2 tion.
