## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of the Congress favoring the authorization, in the manner provided by law, of the establishment of a commemorative work in the District of Columbia to honor the veterans of the Persian Gulf War.

1       *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring)*, That it is the sense of the Congress that a  
3 commemorative work to honor the veterans of the Persian  
4 Gulf War should, subject to the procedures and require-  
5 ments of the Commemorative Works Act (40 U.S.C. 1001  
6 et seq.), be authorized to be established on Federal lands  
7 in the District of Columbia and its environs. For the pur-  
8 poses of this resolution, the term “veterans of the Persian

- 1 Gulf War” means those individuals who while on active
- 2 duty as members of the Armed Forces participated in the
- 3 Persian Gulf War.
