## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for an adjournment of both Houses.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-  
3 tive day of Thursday, June 25, 1998, it stand adjourned  
4 until 12:30 p.m. on Tuesday, July 14, 1998, or until noon  
5 on the second day after Members are notified to reassem-

1 able pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolution,  
2 whichever occurs first; and that when the Senate recesses  
3 or adjourns at the close of business on Friday, June 26,  
4 1998, Saturday, June 27, 1998, or Sunday, June 28,  
5 1998, pursuant to a motion made by the Majority Leader,  
6 or his designee, in accordance with this concurrent resolu-  
7 tion, it stand recessed or adjourned until noon on Monday,  
8 July 6, 1998, or such time on that day as may be specified  
9 by the Majority Leader or his designee in the motion to  
10 recess or adjourn, or until noon on the second day after  
11 Members are notified to reassemble pursuant to section  
12 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first.

13       SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority  
14 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation with  
15 the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority Lead-  
16 er of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the House  
17 and the Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever, in  
18 their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
