## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the use of the Capitol grounds for the American Luge Association Races.

1        *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*  
2        *concurring),*

3        **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF AMERICAN LUGE RACES**  
4        **ON CAPITOL GROUNDS.**

5        The American Luge Association (in this resolution re-  
6        ferred to as the “Association”) shall be permitted to spon-  
7        sor a public event, luge races, on the Capitol grounds on  
8        August 8 and 9, 1998, or on such other date as the Speak-  
9        er of the House of Representatives and the President pro  
10       tempore of the Senate may jointly designate.

1 **SEC. 2. CONDITIONS.**

2       The event to be carried out under this resolution shall  
3 be free of admission charge to the public and arranged  
4 not to interfere with the needs of Congress, under condi-  
5 tions to be prescribed by the Architect of the Capitol and  
6 the Capitol Police Board; except that the Association shall  
7 assume full responsibility for all expenses and liabilities  
8 incident to all activities associated with the event.

9 **SEC. 3. STRUCTURES AND EQUIPMENT.**

10       For the purposes of this resolution, the Association  
11 is authorized to erect upon the Capitol grounds, subject  
12 to the approval of the Architect of the Capitol, such stage,  
13 sound amplification devices, and other related structures  
14 and equipment as may be required for the event to be car-  
15 ried out under this resolution.

16 **SEC. 4. ADDITIONAL ARRANGEMENTS.**

17       The Architect of the Capitol and the Capitol Police  
18 Board are authorized to make any such additional ar-  
19 rangements that may be required to carry out the event  
20 under this resolution.
