JOINT RESOLUTION

Making technical corrections to the Omnibus Consolidated Appropriations Act, 1997 (Public Law 104–208), and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. Title III of the Departments of Com-
4 merce, Justice, and State, the Judiciary, and Related
5 Agencies Appropriations Act, 1997 (as contained in DIVI-
6 SION A, TITLE I—OMNIBUS APPROPRIATIONS,
7 section 101(a) of the Omnibus Consolidated Appropria-
8 tions Act, 1997, Public Law 104–208) is amended under
9 the heading “COURTS OF APPEALS, DISTRICT COURTS,
10 AND OTHER JUDICIAL SERVICES—DEFENDER SERVICES”

1 by striking “attorneys ap-” at the end and inserting the
2 following: “attorneys appointed to represent jurors in civil
3 actions for the protection of their employment, as author-
4 ized by 28 U.S.C. 1875(d); \$308,000,000, to remain avail-
5 able until expended as authorized by 18 U.S.C.
6 3006A(i).”. The foregoing amendment shall be considered
7 for all purposes to have taken effect on the date of enact-
8 ment of Public Law 104–208, and any actions taken prior
9 to the date of enactment of this section on the basis that
10 Public Law 104–208 should be interpreted as if it in-
11 cluded the amendment made by this section, if otherwise
12 valid, are ratified and approved by Congress.

13 SEC. 2. Title I of the Departments of Labor, Health
14 and Human Services, and Education, and Related Agen-
15 cies Appropriations Act, 1997 (as contained in DIVISION
16 A, TITLE I—OMNIBUS APPROPRIATIONS, section
17 101(e) of the Omnibus Consolidated Appropriations Act,
18 1997, Public Law 104–208) is amended under the heading
19 “EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING ADMINISTRATION—STATE
20 UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE AND EMPLOYMENT SERVICE
21 OPERATIONS” by striking “\$23,452,000” and inserting
22 “\$173,452,000”.

23 SEC. 3. Funds available for title IV–A–1 of the Ele-
24 mentary and Secondary Education Act in title III of the
25 Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services, and

1 Education, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act,
2 1997 (as contained in DIVISION A, TITLE I—OMNI-
3 BUS APPROPRIATIONS, section 101(e) of the Omnibus
4 Consolidated Appropriations Act, 1997, Public Law 104-
5 208) under the heading “SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PRO-
6 GRAMS” shall also be available for title IV–A–2 of the Ele-
7 mentary and Secondary Education Act: *Provided*, That,
8 of the funds under these headings in that Act available
9 July 1, 1997, through September 30, 1998, \$25,000,000
10 shall instead be available October 1, 1996, through Sep-
11 tember 30, 1997.
