Mr. ENGLISH of Pennsylvania (for himself, Mr. SAM JOHNSON of Texas, and Mr. PETERSON of Pennsylvania) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To provide for modification of State agreements under title II of the Social Security Act with respect to certain students.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXEMPTION FOR STUDENTS EMPLOYED BY**
4 **STATE SCHOOLS, COLLEGES, OR UNIVER-**
5 **SITIES.**

6 Notwithstanding section 218 of the Social Security
7 Act, any agreement with a State (or any modification
8 thereof) entered into pursuant to such section may, at the
9 option of such State, be modified at any time before Janu-
10 ary 1, 1998, so as to exclude service performed in the em-

1 ploy of a school, college, or university if such service is
2 performed by a student who is enrolled and is regularly
3 attending classes at such school, college, or university.

4 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE OF MODIFICATION.**

5 Any modification of an agreement pursuant to section
6 1 shall be effective with respect to services performed after
7 the end of the calendar quarter following the calendar
8 quarter in which such agreement is modified.

9 **SEC. 3. IRREVOCABILITY OF MODIFICATION.**

10 If any modification of an agreement pursuant to sec-
11 tion 1 terminates coverage with respect to service per-
12 formed in the employ of a school, college, or university,
13 by a student who is enrolled and regularly attending class-
14 es at such school, college, or university, the Commissioner
15 of Social Security and the State may not thereafter modify
16 such agreement so as to again make the agreement appli-
17 cable to such service performed in the employ of such
18 school, college, or university.
