3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The facility of the United States Postal Service under
5 construction at 150 West Margaret Drive in Terre Haute,
6 Indiana, shall be known and designated as the “John T.
7 Myers Post Office Building”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the facility
4 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference
5 to the “John T. Myers Post Office Building”.
