## A BILL

Making emergency supplemental appropriations for salaries and expenses of the National Weather Service, including the National Centers for Environmental Prediction, for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1997.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That the following sum is appropriated, out of money in  
4       the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to provide emer-  
5       gency supplemental appropriations for the fiscal year end-  
6       ing September 30, 1997:

1 NATIONAL OCEANIC AND ATMOSPHERIC  
2 ADMINISTRATION  
3 OPERATIONS, RESEARCH, AND FACILITIES

4 For an additional amount for “Operations, Research,  
5 and Facilities” for salaries and expenses of the National  
6 Weather Service \$10,000,000, to remain available until  
7 expended, of which \$2,000,000 shall be used for salaries  
8 and expenses of the National Centers for Environmental  
9 Prediction: *Provided*, That the entire amount is designated  
10 by Congress as an emergency requirement pursuant to  
11 section 251(b)(2)(D)(i) of the Balanced Budget and  
12 Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985.
