Mr. SCHUMER (for himself and Mr. NADLER) introduced the following bill;
which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To prevent handgun violence and illegal commerce in
handguns.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Twelve is Enough
5 Anti-Gunrunning Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION AGAINST MULTIPLE HANDGUN SALES**
7 **OR PURCHASES.**

8 (a) PROHIBITION.—Section 922 of title 18, United
9 States Code is amended by adding at the end the follow-
10 ing:

11 “(y)(1) It shall be unlawful for any licensed dealer—

1 (b) FIREARMS TRANSFERS SUBJECT TO INSTANT
2 CHECK.—Section 922(t)(2)(C) of such title is amended by
3 inserting “within 35 calendar days after the date the sys-
4 tem provides the licensee with the number,”.

5 **SEC. 5. REVISED DEFINITION.**

6 Section 921(a)(21)(C) of title 18, United States
7 Code, is amended by inserting “, except that such term
8 shall include any person who transfers more than 1 hand-
9 gun in any 30-day period to a person who is not a licensed
10 dealer” before the semicolon.
