3 **SECTION 1. ABILITY OF DISABLED AMERICAN VETERANS**
4 **CORPORATION TO SUE OR BE SUED IN FED-**
5 **ERAL COURTS.**

6 Section 4 of the Act of June 17, 1932 (36 U.S.C.
7 90d) is amended by inserting “, and in the Federal
8 courts” after “courts of law and equity”.
