## A BILL

To prohibit the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration from closing certain flight service stations.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4        This Act may be cited as the “Community Flight  
5 Safety Act of 1997”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON CLOSING OF CERTAIN FLIGHT**  
7 **SERVICE STATIONS.**

8        Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Ad-  
9 ministrator of the Federal Aviation Administration may  
10 not close any flight service station that—

1           (1) is located in the contiguous United States  
2           and within 50 miles from the Atlantic or Pacific  
3           Ocean, the Gulf of Mexico, or one of the Great  
4           Lakes;

5           (2) on an average of 180 or more days in a cal-  
6           endar year, as determined by the Administrator,  
7           provides services to aircraft operating under instru-  
8           ment flight rules; or

9           (3) meets the requirements of both paragraphs  
10          (1) and (2).
