A BILL

To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to permit certain nonimmigrant aliens to study in publicly funded adult education programs if the alien provides reimbursement for such study.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. NONIMMIGRANT ALIEN STUDY IN PUBLICLY**
4 **FUNDED ADULT EDUCATION PROGRAMS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 214(l)(1) of the Immigra-
6 tion and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1184(l)(1) (as added
7 by section 625(a) of the Illegal Immigration Reform and

1 Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996; Public Law 104–
2 208; 110 Stat. 3009—1820) is amended—

3 (1) in subparagraph (A) by striking “or in a
4 publicly funded adult education program”;

5 (2) in subparagraph (B)—

6 (A) by inserting “or in a public adult edu-
7 cation program” after “secondary school”; and

8 (B) by inserting “or program” after
9 “school” each place it appears.

10 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
11 subsection (a) shall take effect as if included in the enact-
12 ment of section 625 of the Illegal Immigration Reform and
13 Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996.
