Mr. SKAGGS (for himself and Mr. MCINNIS) introduced the following bill;  
which was referred to the Committee on Resources

## A BILL

To designate certain lands in the San Isabel National Forest,  
in Colorado, as the Spanish Peaks Wilderness.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Spanish Peaks Wilder-  
5       ness Act of 1997”.

6       **SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF WILDERNESS.**

7       (a) AMENDMENT.—Section 2 of the Colorado Wilder-  
8       ness Act of 1993 (Public Law 103–77) is amended by add-  
9       ing the following new paragraph at the end of subsection

10      (a):

1           “(20) Certain lands in the San Isabel National  
2           Forest which comprise approximately 18,000 acres,  
3           as generally depicted on a map entitled ‘Proposed  
4           Spanish Peaks Wilderness’, dated May 1997, and  
5           which shall be known as the Spanish Peaks Wilder-  
6           ness.”.

7           (b) MAP AND DESCRIPTION.—As soon as practicable  
8           after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of  
9           Agriculture shall file a map and a boundary description  
10          of the area designated as the Spanish Peaks Wilderness  
11          by paragraph (20) of subsection 2(a) of the Colorado Wil-  
12          derness Act of 1993, as amended by this Act, with the  
13          Committee on Resources of the House of Representatives  
14          and the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources of  
15          the Senate. Such map and boundary description shall have  
16          the same force and effect as if included in the Colorado  
17          Wilderness Act of 1993, except that if the Secretary is  
18          authorized to correct clerical and typographical errors in  
19          such boundary description and map. Such map and bound-  
20          ary description shall be on file and available for public in-  
21          spection in the Office of the Chief of the Forest Service,  
22          Department of Agriculture.

1 **SEC. 3. CONFORMING CHANGE.**

2       Section 10 of the Colorado Wilderness Act of 1993  
3 (Public Law 103–77) is hereby repealed, and section 11  
4 of such Act is renumbered as section 10.
