1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Need-Based Edu-
3 cational Aid Antitrust Protection Act of 1997”.

4 **SEC. 2. CONTINUATION OF FAVORABLE TREATMENT FOR**
5 **NEED-BASED EDUCATIONAL AID UNDER THE**
6 **ANTITRUST LAWS.**

7 (a) AMENDMENTS.—Section 568 of the Improving
8 America’s Schools Act of 1994 (15 U.S.C. 1 note) is
9 amended—

- 10 (1) in the heading of subsection (a) by striking
11 “TEMPORARY”,
12 (2) by striking subsection (d), and
13 (3) by redesignating subsection (e) as sub-
14 section (d).

15 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
16 subsection (a) shall take effect immediately before Sep-
17 tember 30, 1997.
