## A BILL

To continue favorable treatment for need-based educational aid under the antitrust laws.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Need-Based Edu-  
5 cational Aid Antitrust Protection Act of 1997”.

1 **SEC. 2. CONTINUATION OF FAVORABLE TREATMENT FOR**  
2 **NEED-BASED EDUCATIONAL AID UNDER THE**  
3 **ANTITRUST LAWS.**

4 (a) **AMENDMENTS.**—Section 568 of the Improving  
5 America’s Schools Act of 1994 (15 U.S.C. 1 note) is  
6 amended—

7 (1) in the heading of subsection (a) by striking  
8 “TEMPORARY”,

9 (2) by striking subsection (d), and

10 (3) by redesignating subsection (e) as sub-  
11 section (d).

12 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by  
13 subsection (a) shall take effect immediately before Sep-  
14 tember 30, 1997.
