To clarify that the protections of the Federal Tort Claims Act apply to the members and personnel of the National Gambling Impact Study Commission.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. APPLICABILITY OF FEDERAL TORT CLAIMS**
2 **PROVISIONS.**

3 Section 6 of the National Gambling Impact Study
4 Commission Act (18 U.S.C. 1955 note) is amended by
5 adding at the end the following:

6 “(e) **APPLICABILITY OF FEDERAL TORT CLAIMS**
7 **PROVISIONS.**—For purposes of sections 1346(b) and
8 2401(b) and chapter 171 of title 28, United States Code,
9 the Commission is a ‘Federal agency’ and each of the
10 members and personnel of the Commission is an ‘employee
11 of the Government’.”.

12 **SEC. 2. CONSTRUCTION.**

13 The amendment made by section 1 shall not be con-
14 strued to imply that any commission is not a “Federal
15 agency” or that any of the members or personnel of a com-
16 mission is not an “employee of the Government” for pur-
17 poses of sections 1346(b) and 2401(b) and chapter 171
18 of title 28, United States Code.

19 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

20 The amendment made by section 1 shall be effective
21 as of August 3, 1996.
