AN ACT

For the relief of Nuratu Olarewaju Abeke Kadiri.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR NURATU**
2 **OLAREWAJU ABEKE KADIRI.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)
4 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality
5 Act, Nuratu Olarewaju Abeke Kadiri shall be eligible for
6 issuance of an immigrant visa or for adjustment of status
7 to that of an alien lawfully admitted for permanent resi-
8 dence upon filing an application for issuance of an immi-
9 grant visa under section 204 of such Act or for adjustment
10 of status to lawful permanent resident.

11 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Nuratu Olarewaju
12 Abeke Kadiri enters the United States before the filing
13 deadline specified in subsection (c), she shall be considered
14 to have entered and remained lawfully and shall, if other-
15 wise eligible, be eligible for adjustment of status under
16 section 245 of the Immigration and Nationality Act as of
17 the date of the enactment of this Act.

18 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
19 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-
20 plication for issuance of an immigrant visa or the applica-
21 tion for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees
22 within 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.

23 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.—
24 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent resi-
25 dence to Nuratu Olarewaju Abeke Kadiri, the Secretary
26 of State shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by 1,

1 during the current or next following fiscal year, the total
2 number of immigrant visas that are made available to na-
3 tives of the country of the alien's birth under section
4 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act or, if appli-
5 cable, the total number of immigrant visas that are made
6 available to natives of the country of the alien's birth
7 under section 202(e) of such Act.

8 (e) DENIAL OF PREFERENTIAL IMMIGRATION
9 TREATMENT FOR CERTAIN RELATIVES.—The natural
10 parents, brothers, and sisters of Nuratu Olarewaju Abeke
11 Kadiri shall not, by virtue of such relationship, be ac-
12 corded any right, privilege, or status under the Immigra-
13 tion and Nationality Act.
